

# Investing for Success

Under this agreement for 2016

Watson Road State School will receive

**\$155,150\***

## This funding will be used to

1. Ensure all Prep students achieve an age appropriate oral language standard by end 2016 or are engaged with evidence based intensive support.
2. Ensure 40% of Prep students reach a PM level 7 prior to end Semester 2, 2016 (Increase from 16% in 2014).
3. Support Year 3 students to achieve NAPLAN NMS in Reading (to 85% from 54.5% in 2014).
4. Achieve increases in Numeracy NMS: i.e. Year 3 From 73% to 85%; Year 5 From 54% to 75%.

## Our initiatives include

- Improved access to Speech Therapy and Guidance Services assessment, therapy.
- Continue Hearing Screening across the Prep and Year 1 cohorts.
- Robust Vocabulary Instruction introduced with Speech Therapy support as a focus for pedagogical coaching and co-planning.
- Language Leaders pedagogies re-established across the school.
- Providing high level curriculum leadership, coaching and support of classroom teachers to embed school-wide pedagogies and differentiation in planning.
- Maintaining a goal orientated, data reflection cycle to ensure student achievement.
- Professional development and coaching on the teaching of Mathematics and it vocabulary.
